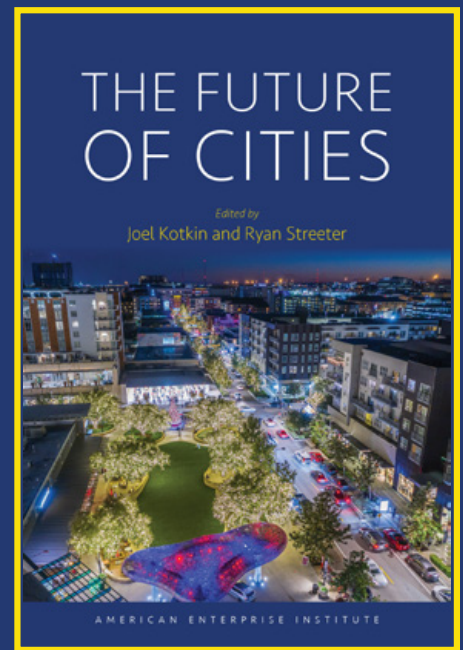


# THE FUTURE OF CITIES
